Board members are legally prohibited from discussing non-agenda items and, therefore, will not respond to items presented in the Open Forum. The board encourages the public to be mindful of, and exercise discretion when making comments about individual students. If you cannot attend the meeting in person, but wish to have your comments read aloud to the Board, they may be submitted to Pam Rennick by 12:00PM on the date of the meeting. The written comments will be subject to the same time limitations.
